Quince to headline CCCRC program in Miami August 20

A seminar on “Bench and Bar Perspectives of a Criminal Trial” is being presented by the Third Region Criminal Conflict and Civil Regional Counsel in Miami on August 20.

The seminar will be held in Courtroom 4-1 at the Richard E. Gerstein Justice Building and is also available via videoconference at the Freeman Justice Center Jury Assembly Room in Key West.
